NURSING INSTRUCTOR Four Full-Time Unlimited Positions

APPLICATION

DEADLINE: Open until filled.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach in the two-year associate degree nursing program. Primary responsibilities include classroom lecture/demonstration, selecting, implementing and evaluating student clinical experiences, and demonstration and practice of selected clinical skills. Participation in discipline, division, campus and college matters through service on committees; attendance at regular meetings; and continued professional development are expected. Faculty hired may expect assignments to include evening and/or online sections. Successful candidates will possess and demonstrate the necessary skills and commitment that support one or more of the college's strategic objectives.

These positions may teach courses associated with both the Cambridge and Coon Rapids campuses of ARCC. The primary teaching responsibilities for two of these positions will be through Cambridge and the other two will be through Coon Rapids.

QUALIFICATIONS: Completed master's degree with a major in nursing, nursing administration, nursing education, public health nursing or a nursing clinical specialty. Two full-time years (or equivalent) of verified related paid work experience as a registered nurse at the professional level. One year of this work experience shall be within the five years immediately preceding the date of application for the credential field. The recency requirement shall be waived if the individual has two years of successful full-time (or equivalent) postsecondary teaching experience in the credential field within the last five years. Current Minnesota RN licensure. (*At time of hire*)

QUALIFICATIONS:

Preference is given to those who have the following: 1) experience using contemporary teaching and student centered learning techniques; 2) previous teaching experience in Nursing; 3) Recent acute care, medical/surgical, maternal/newborn and/or mental health nursing experience; 4) A diverse clinical background; 5) experience with instructional management software to teach online courses.

The applicant should demonstrate knowledge of diverse cultures and populations.
